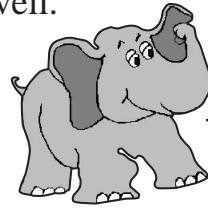


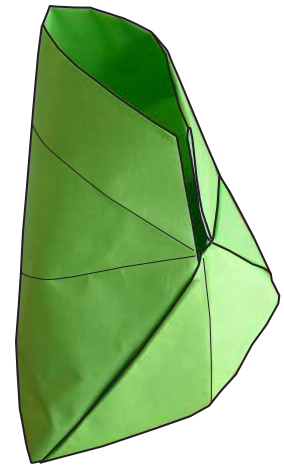
Elephant Slipper

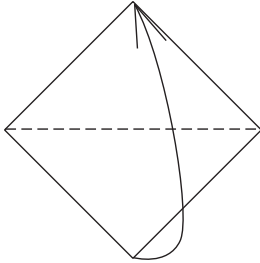
To make a slipper that will fit a life-sized adult elephant, begin with an 8-foot square of extremely sturdy paper. Tyvek HomeWrap® works well.



“That’s a big slipper!”

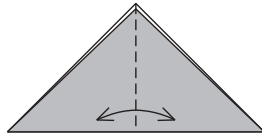

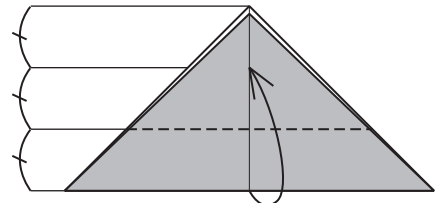
White side up,

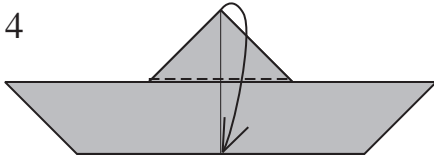
Valley-fold and unfold.

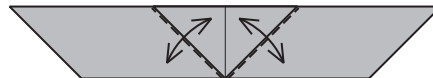
Valley-fold lightly, estimating thirds.

4



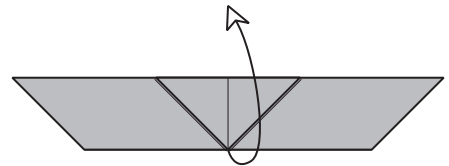
Valley-fold the top point

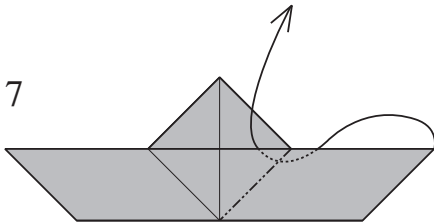
Valley-fold and unfold.

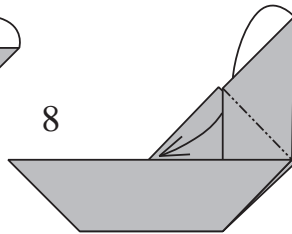
Unfold the top flap.

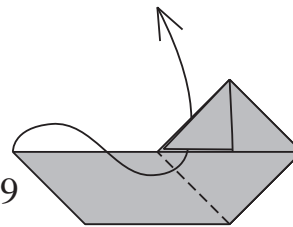
Reverse-fold the right flap.

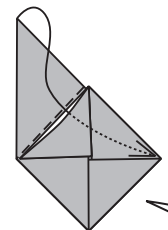
Mountain-fold.

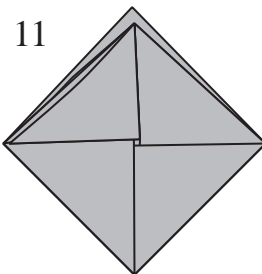
Valley-fold, making

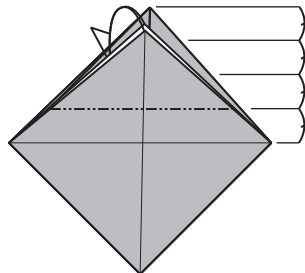
Insert the flap into

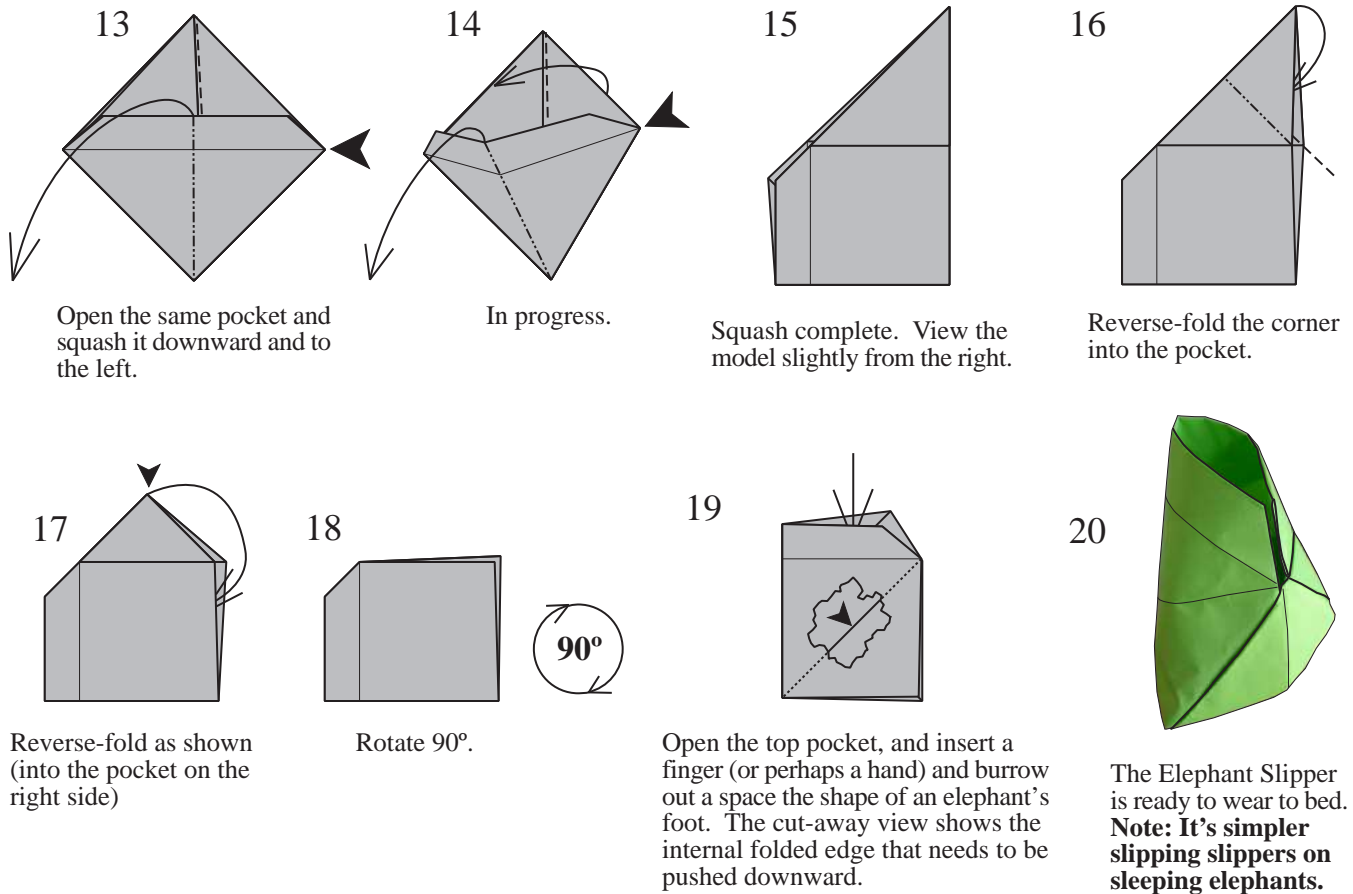


Turn over.

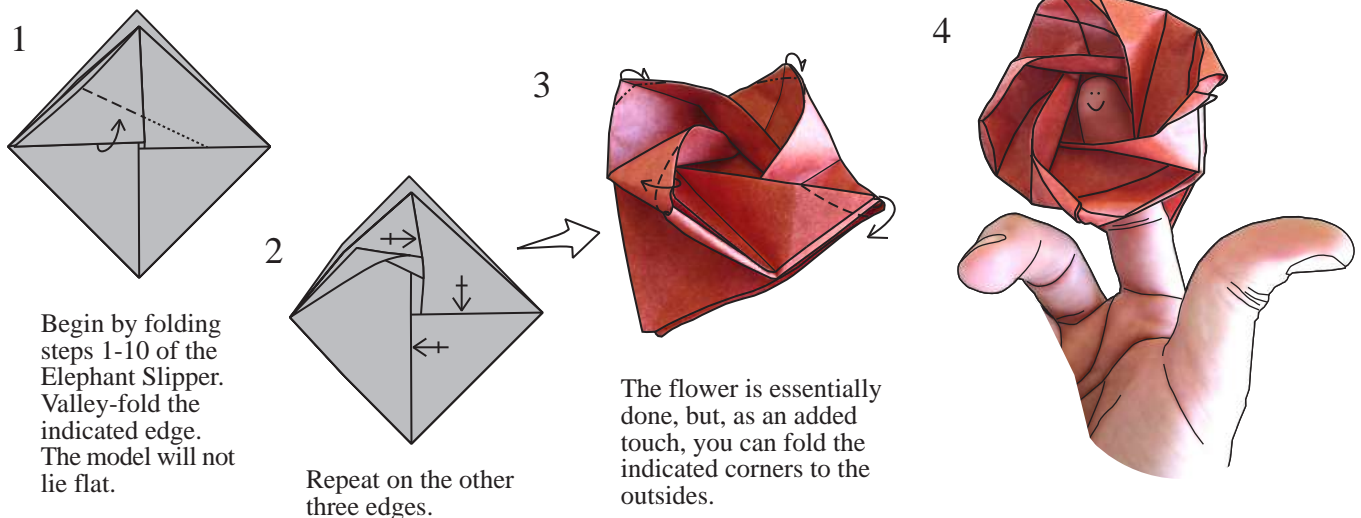
Mountain-fold the two flaps inside
